Five early implementation communities including: Inspiration Field, Imagine!, Mountain Valley, North Metro, and Southern have partially or fully integrated the Individualized Family Service Plan (IFSP) and Child Outcomes Summary (COS) processes in their communities. During their second year of implementation, these communities will continue to adjust and refine practices and make recommendations to state staff. The primary work will focus on evaluation and assessment of the integrated processes.
